

Nomination Guidelines and Application for the Arkansas Athletic Trainers' Association Honorary Membership

Honorary Membership may be bestowed upon (1) that individual [non ATC] who has contributed to and/or promoted athletic training in the State of Arkansas, (2) athletic trainers in other states for contributions to the profession, (3) physicians and/or other allied healthcare professionals, (4) NATA office personnel, (5) coaches, (6) AD's, (7) administrators, (8) parents or others who have contributed significantly to the healthcare and welfare of athletes in the State of Arkansas.

Nomination Process:

- 1) Any AATA member who is in good standing with the AATA may submit "Honorary Membership" nominations to the AATA Honors and Awards Committee. The nominating member is responsible for filling out the application. Forms may be requested from the Chair, or down loaded from the AATA web page.

Qualifications:

- 1) Contributed significantly to the health, care, and welfare for athletes at a certain institution within Arkansas for a minimum of ten years.
- 2) Contributed at least ten years to the promotion of the athletic training profession. (Injury research, personal appearances, speaking engagements, legislative efforts, etc.)
- 3) "Honorary Membership" categories:
 - (1) Athletic Trainers in other districts in the NATA for contributions to the profession.
 - (2) Physicians and other allied health professionals.
 - (3) NATA office personnel.
 - (4) Coaches, AD's, administrators, or athletes who promote AATA/athletic training.
 - (5) Induction as "Honorary Member" of NATA or SWATA will constitute automatic induction as a Honorary Member in the AATA if the inductee resides within Arkansas.

Selection Process:

- 1) The Honors and Awards committee will vote and decide on the recipient(s) and inform the President.

Notification Process:

- 1) All newly approved "Honorary Member", will be notified by the Honors and Awards Committee Chairperson prior to the state meeting date, and asked to respond of their acceptance and attendance at the Honors and Awards Ceremony and Reception. The new "Honorary Member" will be asked to respond of their acceptance and attendance by one week prior to the state meeting date. If the "Honorary Member" is unable to attend, they will need to forward the name of the person they wish to accept their award to the Honors and Awards Chair.

Award Plaque:

- 1) The AATA will issue and "Honorary Member" plaque.
