GUIDELINES

Purpose:

The AATA "Dr. Doug Parker Recognition Award" may be, but does not have to be, given annually to an individual who has served the Association in a dedicated professional manner. This service may be on a volunteer behind the scene basis, through appointed, elected duties or gone above and beyond the call of duty as well as enhancing athletic training in the State of Arkansas. Their time and talents have been for the betterment of the Association and the advancement of the profession.

Nomination Process:

The Honors and Awards committee will offer nominees when deemed worthy of this award to the executive board for their review and vote at the mid-winter board meeting. The Honors and Awards chair will put a notice on the list serve as well as the newsletter if any member thinks that someone is worthy of this award then they can nominate them to the committee for consideration.

Selection Process:

The voting members of the executive board will each cast one vote on a ballot provided by the Chair of the Honors and Awards Committee, at the annual Mid-Winter Meeting. The Chair of the Honors and Awards Committee will collect the ballots, tabulate the votes, and present them to the President for certification of the year's recipient.
